

What to bring

All students must bring their Discovery College hat on camp. No other hat will be acceptable.

Students will need two packs – a larger pack for main equipment (with wheels so it can be easily rolled, or straps making it easy to carry) and a small daypack for hiking, etc. DO NOT bring single strap packs for use as daypack. ALL ITEMS SHOULD BE LABELLED. On the first day of camp, students should wear shorts and t-shirt, socks, trainers, school hat, sun block, insect spray and rain gear if necessary.

Daypack should contain

1 litre water bottle
tissues (wet and dry)
rain gear (weather dependant)
DC Hat
sunblock 35+
insect repellent (natural if possible)
sunglasses
small towel and washcloth
pencil for worksheets/journal writing
snack and lunch (for Day 1) packed in disposable packing
change of clothes (beachwear, **not** swimwear)

Large pack should contain

soap and container
shampoo and conditioner (travel size)
comb or brush
toothbrush, toothpaste, floss
lip balm
lightweight trousers (1 pair)
sandals (preferably with backs)
lightweight long-sleeve shirt (1)
shorts (2)
underwear (2)
socks (2)
small, light weight bath towel
large plastic bag for dirty, wet clothes
t-shirts (2)
woollen jumper or polar fleece jumper (1)
raincoat (light weight shell)
sleepwear (clean shorts and t-shirt are fine)
torch or headlamp and spare batteries
book or magazine (optional)
disposable or digital camera (optional and brought at own risk)
favourite sleep toy (optional)
